Naming Types of Transportation: Nomenclature Cards

Instructions:

Print off one copy of the nomenclature cards.

Cut out the cards, keeping one image and word together, and cutting the other set apart. Paste them to cardstock and cut them out again. Laminate if desired.

Use magnet strip to place a small piece of magnet on the back of each card. Take a cookie sheet along for your child to use and place the cards on.

Beginning Sounds Travel Word Game

Materials: index cards (4x6), printed images, printed letters, Velcro, glue, file folder, paper

Instructions:

Print out the game. Cut out all of the pieces. Place one image on each of the index cards using glue. Place a small square of Velcro below the image. Place another square of Velcro on the back of each card. Then, place a small piece of Velcro on the back of each of the letters. Glue a strip of Velcro on the left-hand side of the file folder. Attach the letters to this strip. Make a small pocket using the cardstock on the right-hand side of the file folder. Place the cards inside. Place one last piece of Velcro on the upper side of the right-hand side of the file folder. Your material is ready to use!

Print off the cards and cut them out. Glue them onto cardstock if desired for added strength or simply laminate them.

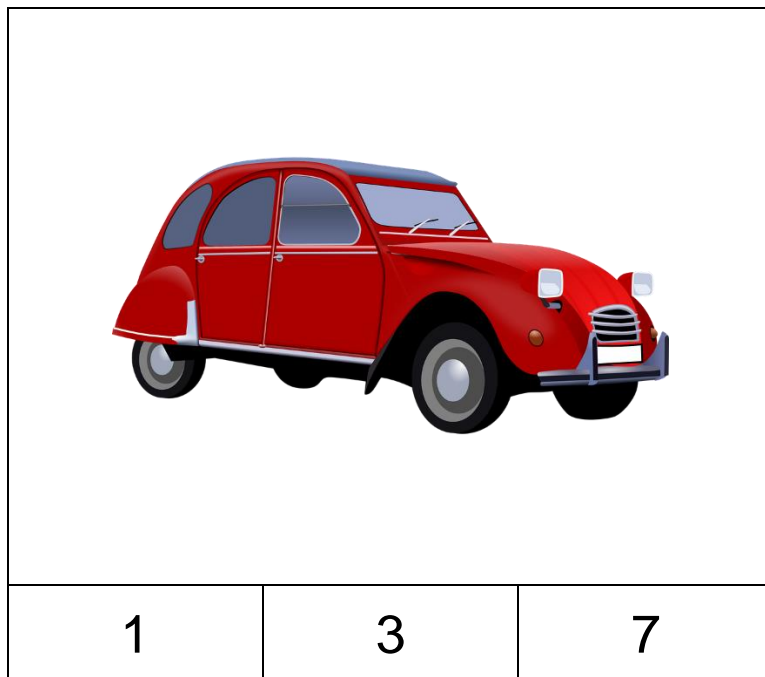

Materials: felt of various colors, cardboard

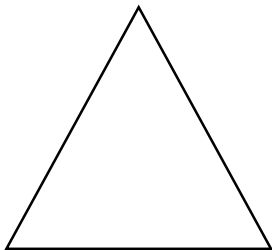
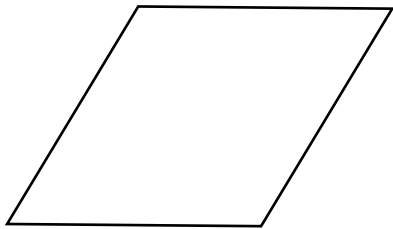
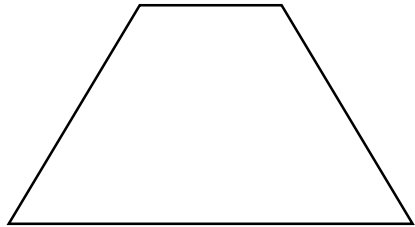
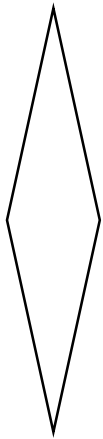
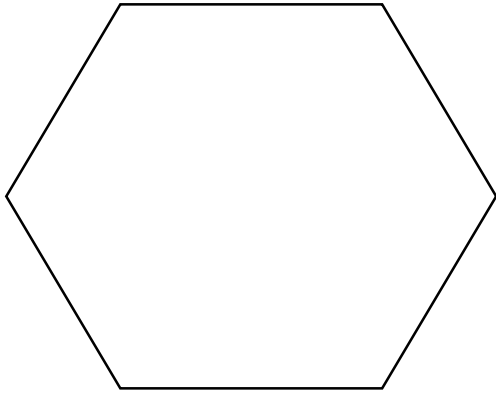
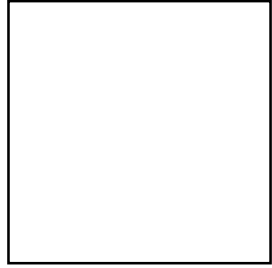
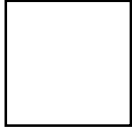
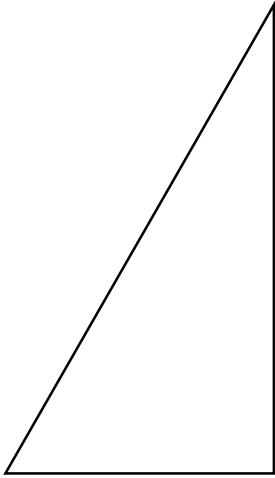
Instructions:

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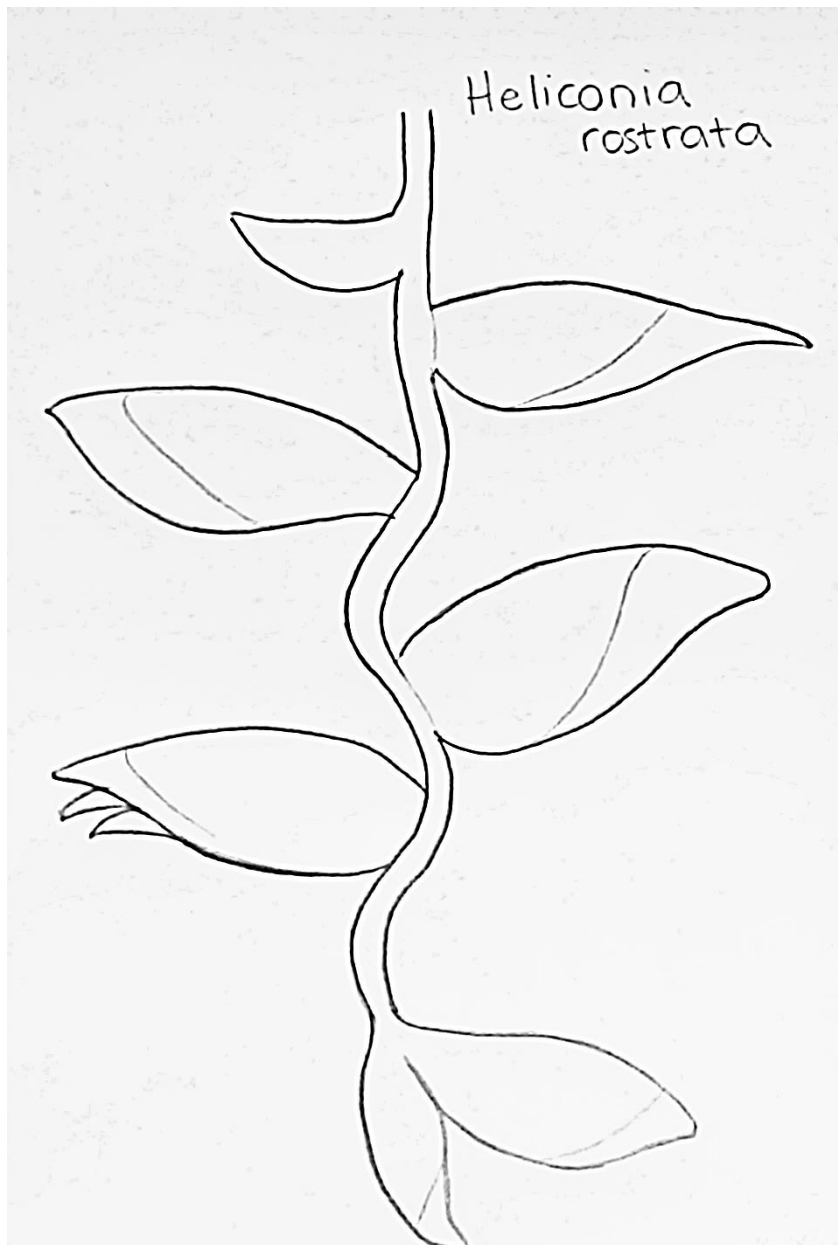


Native Plants and Animals of Guatemala

Instructions: Print off the coloring book. Read through the information with your child and encourage them to color each picture.

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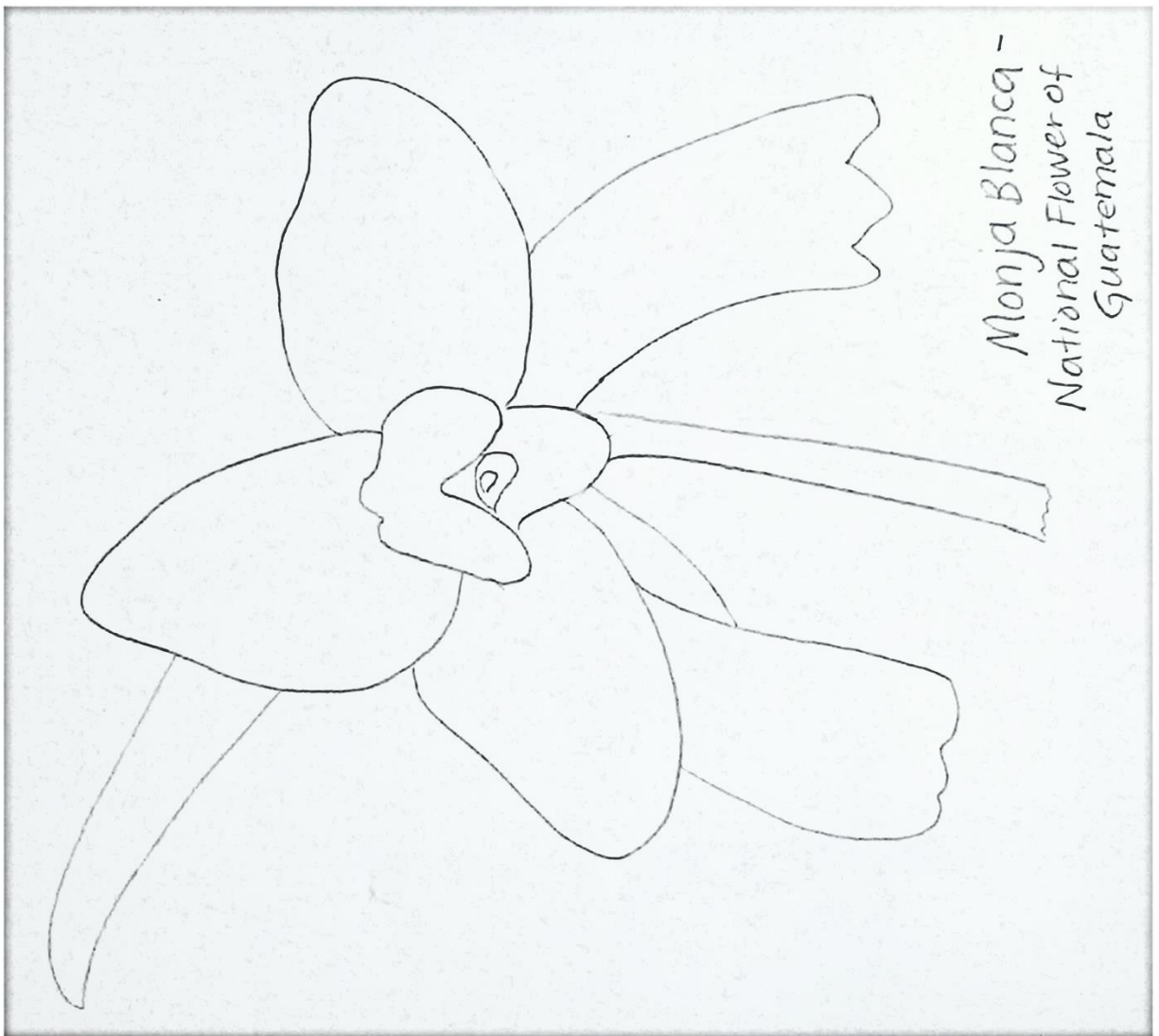
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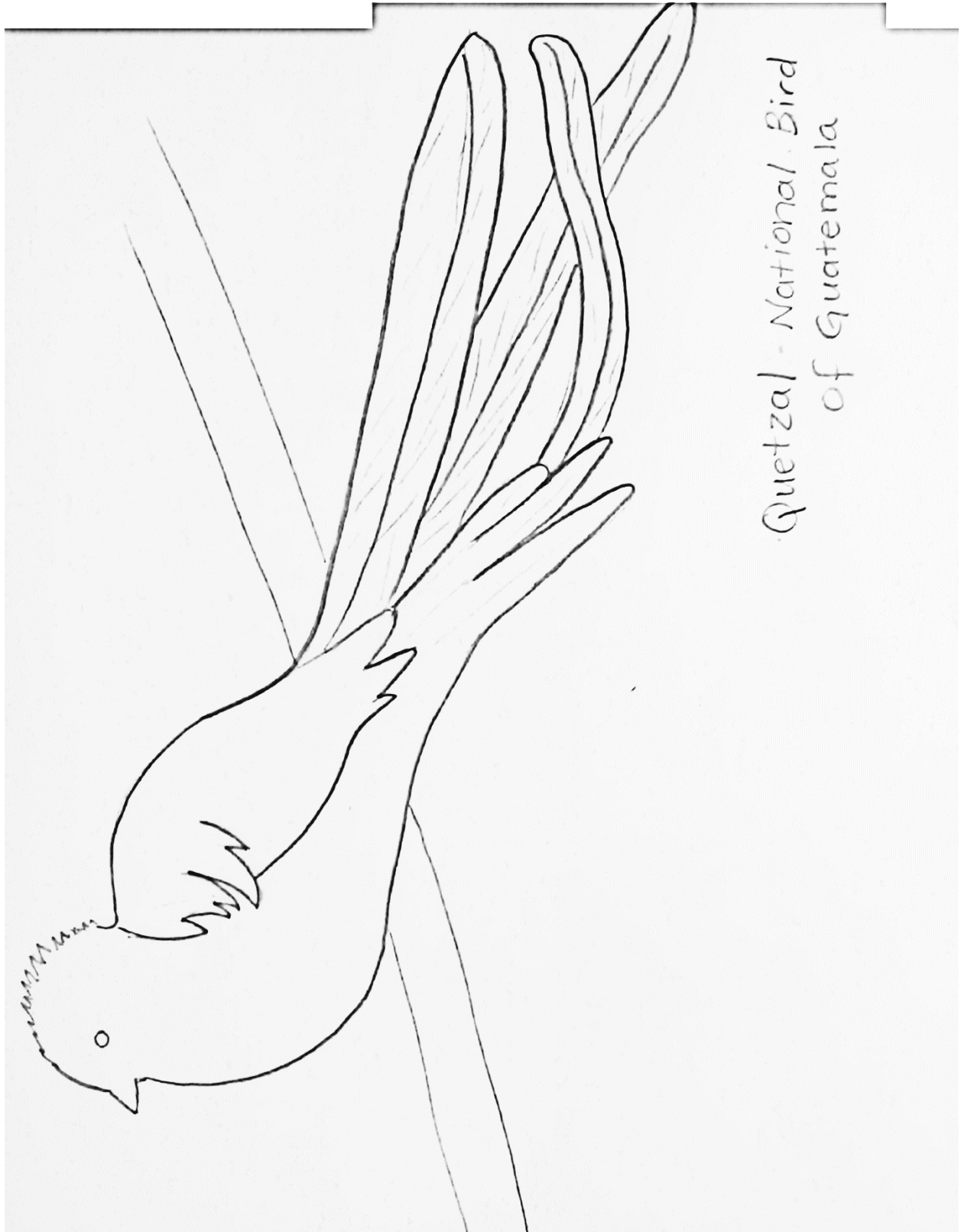
The heliconia rostrata is a beautiful plant that produces red flowers with yellow tips.
