# How Fossils Form

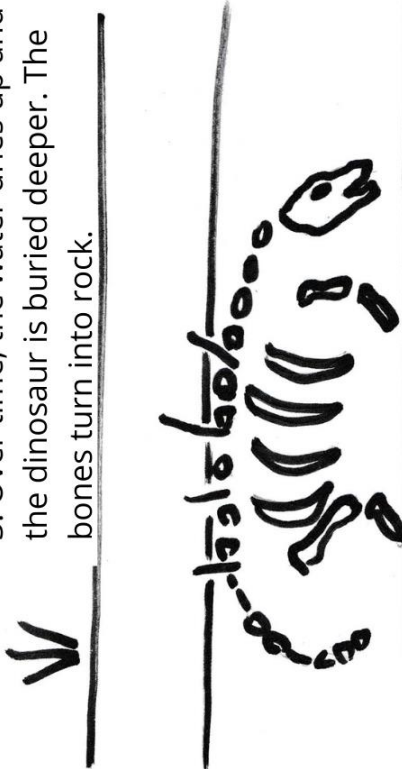
1. A dinosaur dies in a river or lake.



2. The dinosaur's flesh rots away and it is buried in sediment.



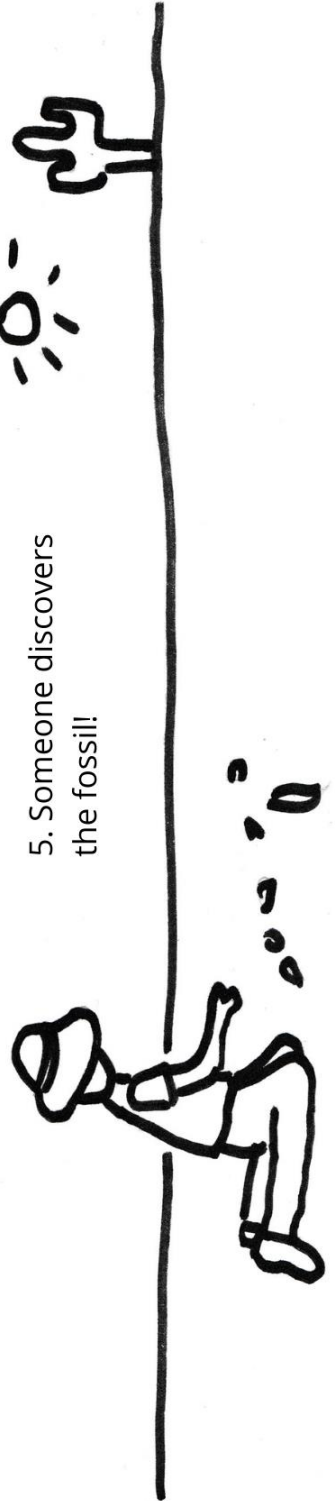
3. Over time, the water dries up and the dinosaur is buried deeper. The bones turn into rock.



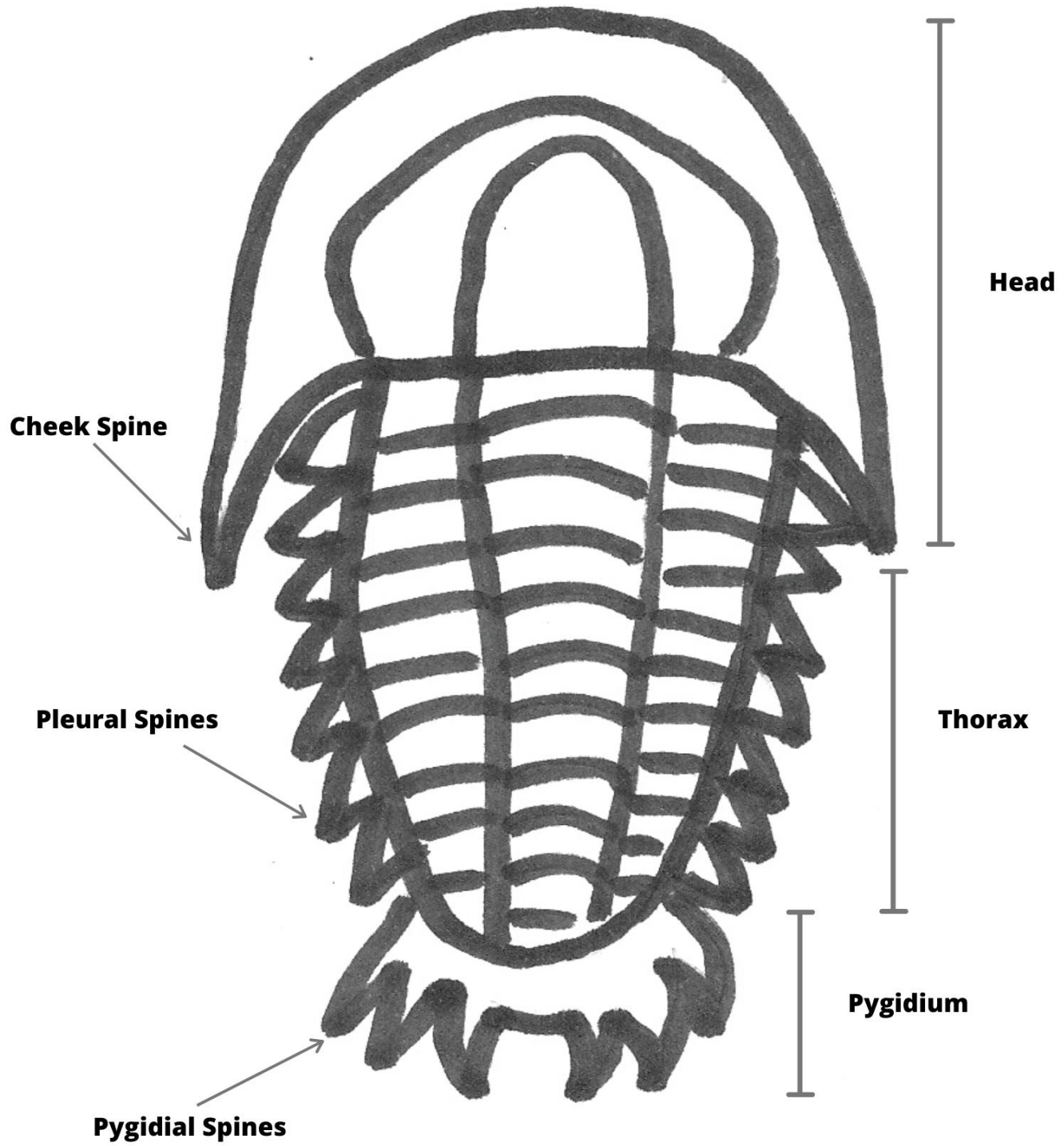
4. Erosion exposes the fossil.



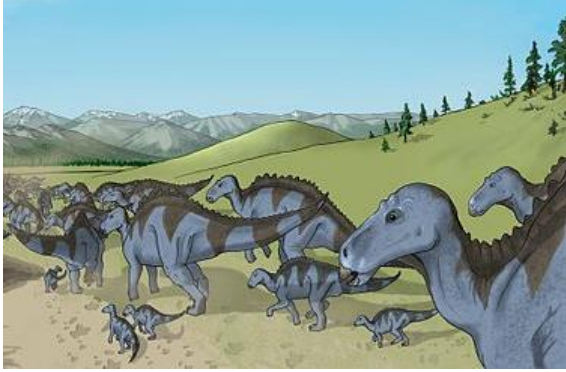
5. Someone discovers the fossil!



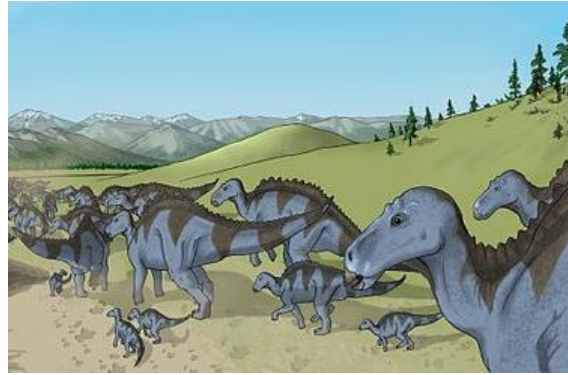
